### **Per Article VII, Section 2, SOUTH CAROLINA LIONS District 32C Constitution & By-Laws Revised: 24 December 2024, Amended 01 February 2025**

Each chartered club in good standing in Lions Clubs International and its district (single or sub- and multiple) shall be entitled in each annual convention of its district (single or sub- and multiple) to one (1) delegate and one (1) alternate for each ten (10) members, who have been enrolled for at least one year and a day in the club or major fraction thereof, of said club as shown by the records of the international office on the first day of the month last preceding that month during which the convention is held PROVIDED, however, that each such club shall be entitled to at least one (1) delegate and one (1) alternate and PROVIDED, however, that any discounted member shall not be included in the club delegate formula. The major fraction referred to in this section shall be five (5) or more members. Each certified delegate sent in person shall be entitled to cast one (1) vote only for each office to be filled by, and one (1) vote only on each question submitted to, the respective convention. Unless otherwise specified herein, the affirmative vote of a majority of the delegates voting on any question shall be the act of the convention. All eligible delegates must be members in good standing of a club in good standing in this district. Delinquent dues may be paid and good standing acquired up to fifteen (15) days prior to the close of credential certification, as such closing time shall be established by the rules of the respective convention.
